DROP OFF * PICK UP * PARKING * IN BUILDING GUIDELINES

DROP OFF: PARENTS NOT COMING INTO THE CLINIC

- Designated drop-off spots will be in front of the building entrance at north side of building.
- Staff member will come out to your car to check your child's temperature and ask COVID screening questions.
- After temperature check, you will be asked to wait in your car or designated area until your therapist is ready for your child.
- Staff member will escort your child to their therapist who will be waiting at the entrance door.
- Do not stay parked in the drop off parking spots. Please move your car and park along the tree line across from the entrance door or additional parking is available at the south end of the complex by the dumpster area. Please watch carefully for moving cars and client families as all learn the system.
- Do not park along the side of the building, those spots are reserved for other businesses in the complex.

DROP OFF/PARKING: PARENTS ATTENDING WITH CHILD

*****PRIOR APPROVAL REQUIRED BY THERAPIST FOR ATTENDING WITH CHILD*****

- Designated parking spots will be in front of the building at the east end (grassy hill area) of the lot along the sidewalk. Handicap spots will also be available.
- Staff member will come out to your car to check temperatures and ask COVID screening questions.
- After temperature check, you will be asked to wait in your car or designated area until your therapist is ready for your child.
- As a precaution and to follow social distancing and capacity requirements set forth by the governor and CDC, we are asking that only one parent enter the clinic with the child at this time.

PARKING: ADULT PATIENTS

- Please park along the tree line across from the entrance door. Do not park along the side of the building, those spots are reserved for other businesses in the complex.
- Staff member will come out to your car and check your temperature and ask COVID screening questions.
- After your temperature check, you will be asked to wait in your car or designated area for your therapist or staff member to bring you into the clinic.

ONCE IN THE BUILDING:

- Hand sanitizer used by all entering the building at check-in.
- All accompanying parents must have a mask on at all times.
- If your child has a facemask and will wear it, we ask that they do so.
- Therapist will be wearing masks or face shields. Protective gowns, (which will be changed between clients), may be worn during session as required for client safety.
- Each therapist will have a designated treatment area or room.
- Flow patterns through the clinic will be indicated on the floor to decrease crossing paths.
- Restrooms should only be used as an emergency. Please have your child use the restroom prior to arriving to the clinic. Restrooms must be disinfected after each use. Time cleaning the restroom reduces treatment time.
- Speech therapist may use plexiglass dividers during sessions vs wearing the mask or face shields.
- All areas will be disinfected before and/or after each client with COVID-19 approved disinfectant.
- All toys/equipment/etc. will be disinfected before and/or after each client use with COVID-19 approved disinfectant.
- Therapists will be cleaning hands before and after each session, as well as during the session when required.
- Therapy sessions will end 5-10 minutes earlier than usual to allow for patient transfer and thorough cleaning of room and equipment used.
- Patient will use hand sanitizer at end of session upon returning to parent.

PICK UP: ALL PATIENTS WILL EXIT THE BUILDING THROUGH THE SIDE (WEST) DOOR.

- Designated parking spots at the side door will be for patient pick up only.
- PLEASE ONLY PARK IN PEDIPLAY DESIGNATED SPOTS.
- Children without a parent will be escorted outside for parent pick up by staff member and delivered to your car. Staff will not be responsible for securing children in the car.
